

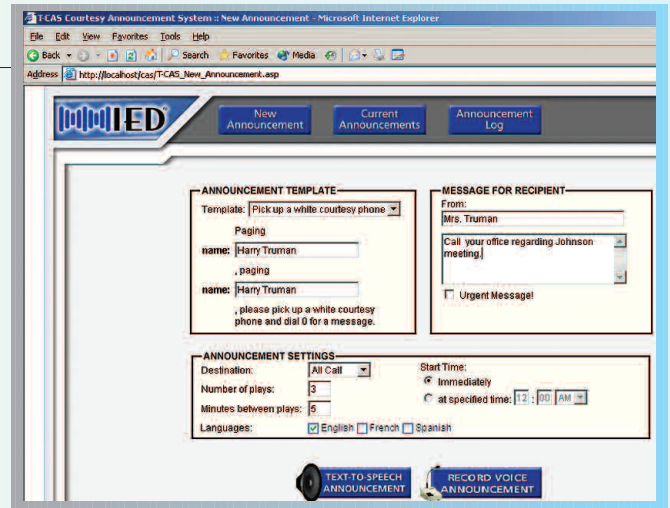
IED announces a browser based software package to initiate courtesy announcements in airport and public facility paging systems. The IED T-CAS<sup>®</sup> (pronounced TEE-cass) Courtesy Announcement System<sup>®</sup> is a client/server web application, utilizing a SQL Server back-end, and is used in conjunction with the IED 500ACS Announcement Control System<sup>®</sup>.

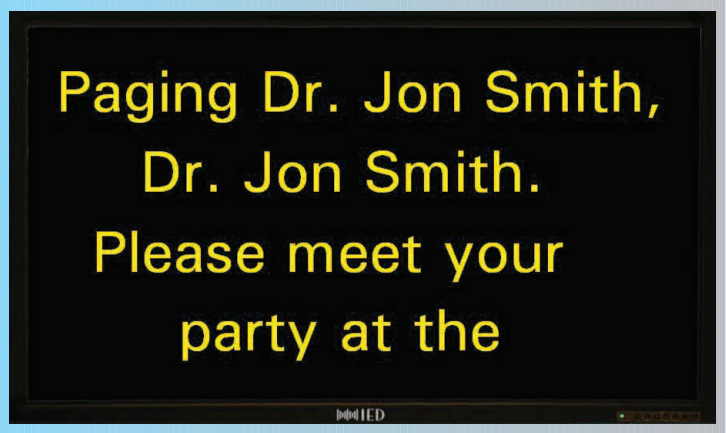
## Text-To-Speech

T-CAS provides "text-to-speech" announcement creation in multiple languages. Since it is browser based, it can be run from any computer with proper network access. The "text-to-speech" message creation provides ultimate flexibility in generating fast message templates and "on the fly" ad-hoc messaging. In addition to the "text-to-speech" functionality, the T-CAS system also interfaces to IED microphone stations for live recorded operator announcements.



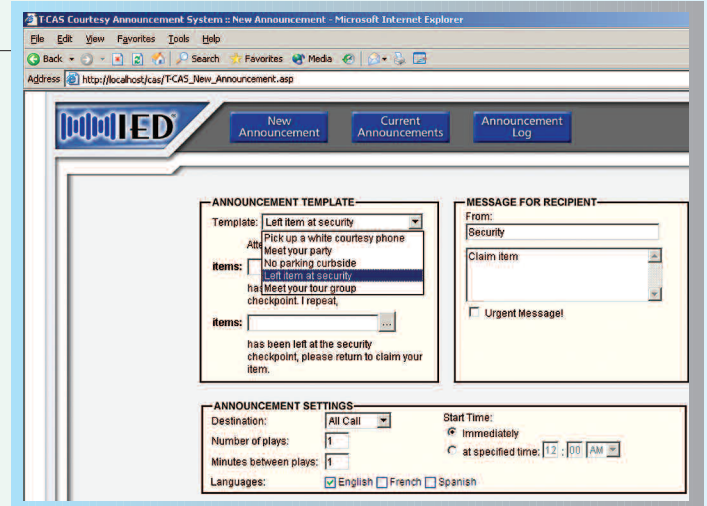
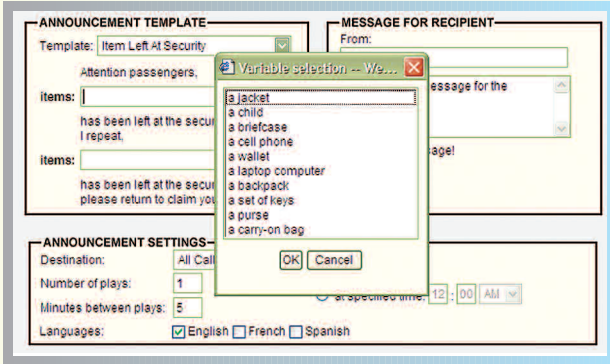
## ADA Compliance

T-CAS provides a simple solution for complying with ADA guidelines for visual paging. The announcements generated through T-CAS and the IED Announcement Control Systems<sup>®</sup> easily integrate with the IED VIS Visual Information System for visual paging on customer information displays.

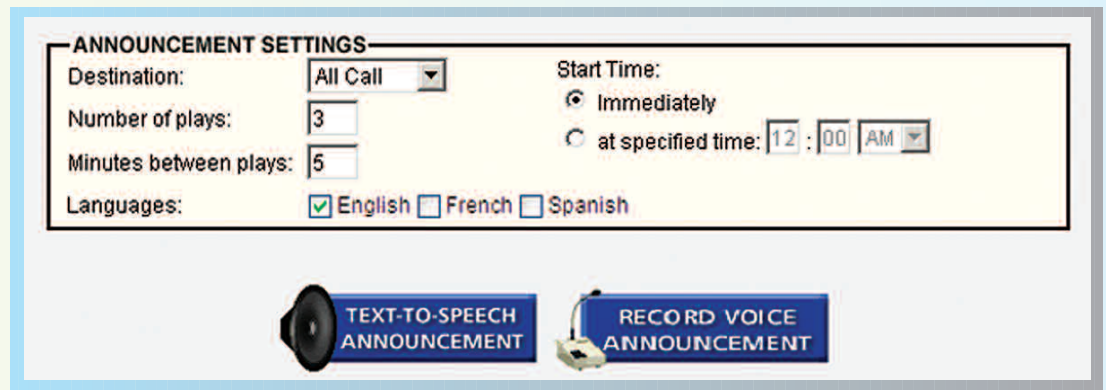


## Pre-Built Templates

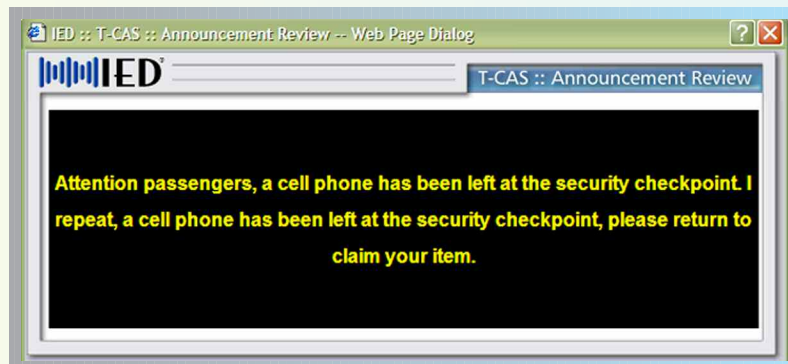
T-CAS® builds announcements through a set of user-defined templates. To build the announcements, you select a template (meet your party, courtesy phone message, left item, etc.) and complete the presented variable fields with the appropriate data (the person’s name, meeting place, item, etc.).



Next, you set the automatic repetition, indicate where the announcement is to be sent, and select “Text-to-Speech” or “Voice” announcement.



The text for the assembled announcement automatically displays on the computer screen, and you can hit send to play the message with the IED Text-to-Speech engine or record the announcement into the microphone while reading the text.



Once the private message is delivered, the announcement is moved from the active announcement list to the archives, where it remains as a permanent record of courtesy announcement activity. You can display and review these archives at any time.
